



BRYCE CARNINE MEMORIAL PRIZE IN ONCOLOGY – AWARD TERMS

One \$3,550 prize has been endowed by Grant and Beryl Carnine to honour their son, Bryce Carnine. The prize is awarded to an **undergraduate or graduate student** in the Faculty of Health and Social Development at The University of British Columbia Okanagan who has conducted a research project or special initiative related **in Oncology as it relates to the prevention and/or cure of cancer, or its relation to improving quality of life to cancer patients**. Scholastic achievements of candidates are also considered. The award is made on the recommendation of the Faculty of Health and Social Development.

Eligibility: All currently registered students in FHSD: Canadian, Permanent Residents, and International students are eligible for this prize.

Deadline: April 14, 9AM PDT

Value: \$3,550
